NaTourKids Project for Class 3 pupils in Braunschweig

Dear Parents,

We are continuing on from the KulTourKids project, with which we have been showcasing the cultural sites of Braunschweig for Class 3 pupils over the past three years, with the NaTourKids project. In this project, the Braunschweig Bürgerstiftung (civic trust) is backed by the Municipality of Braunschweig's Environmental Affairs department. It would like to get all Class 3 pupils interested in getting acquainted with places in Braunschweig where they can experience nature and where options especially for schoolchildren are in place. The initiative is open to those attending primary schools [Grundschulen] and specially-provisioned schools [Förderschulen] in Braunschweig (both state and private).

At school, your child will be handed a folder marked "NaTourKids", in which you will find:

- A **puzzle book**, "Die Rallye um Sonnenland" ("The Race to Save Sunnyland") put together especially for the project. Once again it features the young sleuths Hannah and Louis, who show children the way to natural settings. It allows children to get acquainted with various natural settings in Braunschweig by following an exciting mystery trail, at the end of which Sunnyland meadow is saved. Wrapped up in this mystery are brainteasers, picture puzzles and colouring-in artwork which impart knowledge in a fun, humorous and instructive way.
- An informative brochure, in which state-run and private-sector natural settings are showcased.
 These allow children in Braunschweig access to nature, or better still, offer them the chance to get
 acquainted with flora and fauna and engage with nature in a hands-on way. Alongside municipal
 parks and green spaces, the booklet features an array of partners who are keen supporters of the
 project.

The children can read and understand the puzzle book and brochure without any help from their parents.

We hope that you and your child are interested in all that is on offer, and that you will visit lots of natural settings in our city.
